#### IMMUNISATION CHARGES

HEPITITIS B (The standard course of immunisation involves three injections at 0, 1 and 6 months.)	£30 per vaccine
ACWY VACCINE (generally given to visitors travelling to high risk areas, also for Hajj purposes see below;)	£40

Visitors who are travelling to Saudi Arabia for the Hajj and Umrah pilgrimages to Mecca will need to produce a certificate of vaccination with a quadrivalent meningitis vaccine before they can be issued with a visa.

Although this vaccine protects for up to five years, the Government of Saudi Arabia will only issue a visa for travellers to Hajj and Umrah if your vaccination certificate is less than three years old. This means that if the last time you had this vaccine was more than three years ago, you will need to have a booster dose to get a new vaccination certificate and a visa.

It is advised that you let the Nurse know you are travelling at the earliest. Vaccines should be given around 6 prior to travelling to ensure maximum protection.
